McCauley's research focuses on the health impacts of and intervention strategies to reduce intimate partner violence, sexual assault, and reproductive coercion with emphasis on victimization among marginalized populations (e.g. sexual and gender minorities, foster youth and incarcerated women.).

During April's Noontime Educational Forum, she will discuss her most recent research on IPV, sexual assault and reproductive coercion and its impact on LGBTQ populations.
